Swiss School Abroad

Summer- and winter camps for Children from Swiss Schools

The Foundation for young Swiss Abroad (SJAS) now also offers its camps for children attending Swiss Schools. Please take note of the following information:

Registration

Registration opens on **February 15** for summer camps and **August 1** for winter camps. Early or incomplete registrations will not be considered and will be deleted. Otherwise, the same participation conditions apply to all children (see General Terms & Conditions).

After registration, the following documents must be sent within **7 days** to info@sjas.ch:

- Copy of passport or ID card (any nationality)
- Confirmation from the Swiss School
- Copy (front and back) of the health insurance card (EU countries: blue EU card is mandatory)

Insurance

SJAS does **not** provide health, accident, or rescue insurance for children from Swiss schools. Parents are responsible for obtaining the necessary insurance to ensure medical care in case of an emergency. All incurred costs are at the parents' expense.

- Parents must arrange health and accident insurance for their child.
- We recommend purchasing travel insurance that covers all of the above points.

Finances

SJAS does **not** receive state subsidies for non-Swiss children, which is why the camp fee is slightly higher.

- The camp fee is **CHF 200.-** higher
- SJAS does **not** offer financial support
