SJAS for Everyone

Our camps are open to children from the Swiss School and non-Swiss children (with the exception of Lenk BE - JUSKILA). Please note the following information when registering:

Registration

Registration opens on **February 15** (for summer camps) und **August 1** (for winter camps). Early or incomplete registrations will not be considered and will be deleted. Otherwise, the same participation conditions apply to all children (see Terms and Conditions) After registration, the following documents must be sent to info@sjas.ch within **7 days**:

- A copy of the passport or identity card (regardless of nationality)
- Confirmation from the Swiss School (if possible)
- A copy of the front and back of the health insurance card (for EU citizens: the <u>European Health</u> <u>Insurance Card</u> is mandatory)

Insurance

Non-Swiss participants must have health, accident, and rescue insurance to ensure comprehensive medical care in case of an emergency. This is the responsibility of the parents, who must cover all associated costs.

- Parents are required to take out valid health and accident insurance for their child.
- SJAS recommends additionally purchasing travel insurance that covers all the abovementioned insurances in Switzerland.

Finances

SJAS currently only conducts fundraising for young Swiss citizens living abroad (<u>see foundation</u> <u>purpose</u>) and only receives sports funding for these participants (<u>see J+S</u>). Therefore, the camp fee is slightly higher for non-Swiss participants.

- The camp fee includes an additional CHF 200.
- SJAS cannot offer financial support.
