

Why is it worth attending this course?

- Previously acquired skills are applied and deepened, for example planning camp activities and creating the safety concept for an entire camp.
- Your perspective on running a camp is broadened through work on the administration, planning, implementation, and evaluation of a complete camp programme.
- It is an opportunity to reflect on your role and responsibilities as a team leader and to receive external feedback.
- You will receive tips and tricks for working with the wider network around a camp, such as the head office, parents, property owners, and others.
- You will refresh your Y+S recognition in CS/T and obtain the official recognition as a Y+S Main Camp Leader in CS/T. This recognition enables you to register school camps, class trips, and youth association camps as official Y+S camps.
- The course also offers experience sharing and the chance to reconnect with like-minded participants.

Course costs:

The costs amount to CHF 350 (CHF 450 for external participants), which you have to pay yourself. If you lead two summer camps for the SJAS and/or OSA as an Y+S main camp leader within four years of attending the course, the course fee will be refunded in full in two instalments. At the same time, attending the advanced course extends the repayment period for the basic course fee by two years.

Youth leave and/or confirmation for your employer:

It is possible to take five days of youth leave for the course (provided you are under 30 years old and submit the application to your employer two months in advance). We can also issue you with a confirmation of course attendance for your employer.
